Shorter wait times for the settlement of benefits at retirement

MEMO TO EMPLOYEES

The *Régime complémentaire de rentes des techniciens ambulanciers / paramédics et des services préhospitaliers d'urgence* – RRTAP has established a new process **that considerably reduces wait times** for the settlement of benefits at retirement.

Starting on September 21, 2017, the new approach that is being proposed will allow you to receive your pension **starting on the first day of your retirement**. This payment will be established based on the estimate sent to you before the date of your retirement. For payments to begin, your application for retirement must be sent to the administrator three (3) months before the first day of your retirement. All other required documents must be **sent to the administrator at least one (1) month before** the start of your retirement.

The transfer of the benefits in the defined contribution portion will also be accelerated. An initial payment will be made in the week following your retirement, based on the balance known at that time.

Lastly, **three (3) months after the start of your retirement**, the administrator will adjust the amount of your pension to take into account the last contributions that you made. You will receive a special amount to make up for the difference between the projected pension which you will have received until now and the final pension following the contribution adjustment. In addition, you will receive the final payment of your benefits in the defined contribution portion.

To benefit from this option, we invite you to talk to your employer. Your employer will receive instructions by September 21, 2017 on the eligibility conditions and the procedure to follow.
